SHORT SYNOPSIS

A product of the foster care system, Mathieu, 19, leads an ordinary life, shaped by his work at a slaughterhouse and distant relationships with those around him. An unexpected call from his free-spirited older sister, Heidi, who abruptly left for the United States three years earlier and now wishes to return to home, prompts him to embark on an unfamiliar journey. Along the way back home, a shared past marked by neglect, absence, and resentment resurfaces, making their reunion difficult.

This emotional road movie explores the complexity of bonds within broken families.
