LOGLINE

Anna's last wish is to reunite with her sisters, still traumatized by the actions of their father, convicted of rape.

SHORT SYNOPSIS

Anna, 18 years old, requests medical assistance to die. The date she has set for herself gives her only fifteen days to fulfill her wish of seeing her half-sisters again before she fades away. Separated by events related to their shared father, Eve and Eléonore are forced to reconnect with Anna. Each one's strength is revealed through this journey, which requires them to overcome their fears and emotional limitations. By allowing themselves to be open to the complex lives of the other two, they will find sisterhood beyond their disagreements regarding their father, who has been convicted of rape.

Primary target – Cinephiles between 35-54 years old

Secondary target – Adults between 25-34 years old

Where Do Our Souls Go focuses on the lives of five women who have endured shame due to their father's misconduct and sexual assaults on several women. The spectator will be emotionally invested in the story through the intertwined female perspectives on family love, driven by an unwavering determination to love no matter what, to reunite, and to heal.
